### **Primary Purpose of the Safety Committee:**

To promulgate and enforce standards for the safety and security of rowers and guests of CRF and its Member Organizations, and property, on and off the water.

### **Scope – Responsible for:**

1. Adopting standards which are codified in the Safety Manual (“SaM”).
2. Enforcing the SaM’s standards including conducting hearings on any alleged violations.
3. Conducting training on new standards and refresher training on existing standards as necessary.
4. Encouraging compliance with the SaM.

### **Goals—2018:**

1. Transition safety documentation from paper-based system to electronic system. Included are incident report forms, safety certification applications, and CPR and ODNR documentation.
2. Maintain electronic database tracking safety certification documents for individual participants.
3. Create testing subcommittee responsible for administering written safety exams.

### **Authority—Specifically authorized to:**

1. Conduct Safety Committee Meetings.
2. Chair: Initiate enforcement of the SaM.
3. Members: Assist in testing and training those who hold or wish to hold safety ratings, or who wish to advance in a rating.
4. Deliberate on proposed changes to the SaM as needed.
5. Implement changes to the SaM.
6. Deliberate, decide upon, and implement disciplinary actions as needed.
