**Cathy Duhigg Gannon** has been a member of CRF since 2005, when she started rowing in WRRRA's SRL and FRL programs. In 2009, she started rowing more frequently through the Sweeps program, and rowed in 2016 with WRRRA's Masters' program. She is additionally certified as an independent sculler and is currently rowing in this capacity.

Cathy managed national workers' compensation programs for 26 years working first for BP America and then for Eaton Corporation, serving most recently as Senior Workers' Compensation Manager for the U.S. and Canadian workers' compensation programs covering 37,000 employees working in more than 150 facilities.

Cathy has a BA from Malone College and a Certified Workers' Compensation Professional (CWCP) designation from Michigan State University. She co-chaired the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation and Ohio Industrial Commission Agency Review at the request of then Governor-elect Ted Strickland in 2006, was a past president and Board member of the Self-Insurers' Group of Ohio, and a past Treasurer, Vice President and Board member of the Ohio Self-Insurers' Association. She additionally served on the Industrial Commission Nominating Council, having been appointed by Governor Taft and reappointed by Governors Strickland and Kasich, was selected by the Ohio Manufacturers Association to serve on a committee that worked directly with the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation to restructure the securitization of the Self-Insured Employers' Guarantee Fund, and has testimony to the State of Ohio Legislature on matters pertaining to workers' compensation as well as on pending legislation. Cathy has spoken on workers' compensation topics at national, state-specific, and regional conferences, and is a nationally recognized workers' compensation subject matter expert.
