Kirk Lang currently serves as the Executive Director of the Cleveland Rowing Foundation, where he is responsible for all boathouse operations, intra-program relations, public relations, coordination of special events, and fundraising.

Prior to joining the Cleveland Rowing Foundation, Kirk was a Program Coordinator and Research Assistant at Case Western Reserve University, where he focused on oral health disparities and oversaw the DMD-Masters in Clinical Research T32 Training Grant program. Prior to that, Kirk worked at UPMC Mercy Hospital as a Laboratory Assistant. Kirk graduated from Duquesne University and received his Bachelors in Biology, minor in Chemistry, as well as his Masters of Science in Biotechnology.

Kirk began his rowing career at Mt. Lebanon High School and continued as a heavy-weight rower at Duquesne University where he later became the Head Coach of the Men's Rowing program. Kirk has served on the Cleveland Rowing Foundation Board and is entering his 8th year as the Masters Head Coach for the Western Reserve Rowing Association. Kirk also serves on the CMSD-Rows Board as the Program and Operations Chair.
