Tim Marcovy was one of the five founders of the Western Reserve Rowing Association (WRRRA) in 1989, and assisted in the founding of the CRF (formerly the Western Reserve Rowing Foundation) in 1995. He has served as president, secretary and vice president of the WRRRA at various times, and has served on the Board of Trustees of the WRRRA and the Board of Directors of the CRF. He was Chair of the CRF Safety Committee from 1995 – 2006, and 2012-2015. He has been and currently is on the Board of Directors of the Spartan Alumni Rowing Association (SARA), the alumni support organization for Case Western Reserve University Crew Club. He has, at various times, assisted in drafting and amending the CRF Safety Manual, the WRRRA Code of Regulations, the CRF Code of Regulations, the SARA Code of Regulations, and bylaws for these organizations.
