Grandfathering of SQL-2'S and SQL-1's into SQL status AND Reciprocity for Coaches at the Foundry

Motions Approved March 2, 2017

1. Grandfathering of SQL-2's and SQL-1's into new SQL status
 - a. Provided they also attend a required Annual 2017 Safety Briefing:
 - i. Those SQL-2's holding such status as of February 27, 2017 are grandfathered into the new SQL status, effective April 15, 2017; and
 - ii. Those SQL-1's holding such status as of February 27, 2017 are grandfathered into the new SQL status, effective April 15, 2017, provided they have also attended an SQL-1 Advancing Session. After April 15, 2017, SQL-1's who have not attended an SQL-1 Advancing Session will become SQL-0's.

2. Reciprocity coaching plan for coaches certified at the Foundry and applying to coach at CRF
 - a. A Foundry coach holding a recognized Coaching Qualification Levels (CQL-Trainee, CQL, and Senior CQL) can apply to CRF for such status to be recognized and adopted by CRF under the following terms:
 - i. The Foundry coach must provide the following:
 1. A completed CRF Safety Application applying for such status;
 2. Proof of passing the written test administered by the Foundry;
 3. Proof of valid CPR certification; and
 4. Proof, if born after January 1, 1982, of successful completion of the ODNR Boater's Safety Class;
 - ii. Notification of the Foundry coach's application for reciprocity at CRF will be provided to the Safety Committee; and
 - iii. The Foundry coach's application must receive written approval by the Safety Committee Chair and at least two other Safety Committee members.
